Do you know the Golf Rules?

Question

1. A player, unable to find his ball, puts another into play. He then finds the original ball in the hole.
2. At a par 3 hole, a player believes his original ball is lost, and plays a provisional on to the green, he finds the original in the hole.
3. A player played to a blind green and putted what he thought was his ball and then finds the original in the hole, and that he had putted the wrong ball.

Answer

The original ball counts in each case, and no penalties are incurred.

Question

In replacing his ball on the green, a player firmly presses his ball into the surface to prevent it being moved by wind or gravity.

Answer

2016.10,(04)

In matchplay - loss of hole, in strokeplay – 2 strokes penalty and must play the ball as it lies. (Deliberating taking action to influence the movement of a ball in play, and altering the physical conditions that affect the playing of the hole.)

Question

As A was making his backswing, B accidentally drops a ball which rolled within 6 inches of A's ball. This startled A' causing him to stop his shot. In equity, should A be allowed to replay the shot ?

Answer

No. Distractions are a common occurrence which players must accept.

Questions

A ball comes to rest near a wasp nest.

Answer

Through the green – without penalty drop within 1 club length of, and not nearer the hole than the nearest spot not nearer the hole that is not dangerous.

In a hazard – as above but, if possible the ball must be dropped in the same hazard and, if not possible, in a similar nearby hazard, neither of them nearer the hole. If it is not possible to drop in a hazard, it may be dropped, UNDER PENALTY OF 1 STROKE, outside the hazard, keeping the point where the original ball lay between the hole and spot on which the ball is dropped.

If interference by anything but the nest makes the stroke clearly impracticable or the situation would be dangerous only through the use of a clearly unreasonable stroke or an unnecessarily abnormal stance, swing, or direction of play, the player may not take relief as above, but take relief under penalty under the rules governing water hazard or ball unplayable.

Note: *There is a nest currently on the 8th*
